DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This recommendation is made as permitted under Section 2(ee) and has not been submitted to or approved by the EPA. This 2(ee) bulletin contains directions for use which do not appear on the package label of ACTION COTTON DEFLOIANT. Always read and follow all label directions, restrictions and precautions when using any pesticide alone or in tank mix combinations. The most restrictive labeling applies when using a tank mix. This labeling must be in possession of the user at the time of pesticide application. This FIFRA section 2(ee) expires December 31, 2022.

USE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DEFOLIATION IN COTTON

RATES	ADJUVANT ¹	GPA	TANK MIXES ²
ACTION at 2-8 oz/a. A sequential application up to 6.0 oz/a may be applied 7 days after the first, if additional defoliation is required.	Crop oil concentrate (COC) or methylated seed oil ³ (MSO) at 1-2 pt/A. Ammonium sulfate (AMS) at 2.0-2.5 lb/a may be added to enhance defoliation.	Ground: 10-20 gpa. For best results, use 15-20 gpa and 50 psi, if cotton canopy is moderate to heavy. Air: 5-10 gpa. Good coverage of cotton is essential for maximum defoliation.	ACTION may be tank-mixed with boll openers such as ethephon (Prep®), regrowth preventers or other defoliants/desiccants such as Ginstar® or Finish®.

¹Under ideal defoliation conditions (warm, sunny days), a non-ionic surfactant may be substituted for COC.

²Please see individual labels for more specific information.

³The crop oil concentrate or methylated seed oil must contain at least 15% emulsifier.

USE RESTRICTIONS FOR ACTION FOR DEFOLIATION IN COTTON

- 1. Always read and follow all label directions when using any pesticide alone or in tank-mix combinations.
- 2. DO NOT exceed 8 fl oz/a/application and 14 fl oz/a/season of ACTION.
- 3. Harvest no sooner than 7 days after the last application of ACTION.
- 4. Do not apply ACTION if rain is expected within 1 hour of application.
- 5. Do not apply ACTION through any type of irrigation system.
- 6. Do not graze animals on green forage or use as feed fewer than 28 days after ACTION application.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions and precautions on the EPA-registered labels. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
