Walnut Husk Fly	16 to 21-1/3 fl oz/A (0.3 to 0.4 lb ai/A)	Apply by ground in a minimum of 50 gal/A with airblast equipment as a full coverage spray or apply by air in a minimum of 10 gal/A. Repeat as needed to maintain control but not more often than every 10 days. Coverage is essential for good control. Apply in sufficient water volume for tree size. Use of higher water volume will assure better coverage. To be used in conjunction with lure or attractant for Walnut Husk Fly for optimal control. Begin applications as common to the production area and the target pest.
