The most restrictive labeling applied when using a tank mix.

#### Restrictions

- Do not apply more than 10 fl oz of Senstar Insecticide (0.078 lb spirotetramat and 0.027 lb pyriproxyfen) per acre per application.
- Do not make more than 2 applications per crop season.
- Do not apply more than 20 fl oz Senstar Insecticide (0.156 lb spirotetramat and 0.055 lb pyriproxyfen) per acre per crop season.
- Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.
- Minimum interval between applications is 14 days.
- Regardless of formulation do not apply more than 0.16 lb spirotetramat and 0.134 lb pyriproxyfen per acre per crop season.
- Certain nonionic and organosilicone adjuvants, which may potentially be used with Senstar Insecticide, have caused intolerable damage to bok choy, napa, mustard spinach, mizuna, and mustard greens when applied alone, in the absence of Senstar Insecticide. Testing has shown that Senstar Insecticide does not increase the potential for damage when used in combination with such adjuvants. Due to the wide variety and composition of spray adjuvants that may be used in combination with Senstar Insecticide, only use a spreading-penetrating adjuvant that is known to be safe to the target crop.

• Do not apply during bloom on crops grown for seed production.
